- Amateur Newspapers from the American Antiquarian Society**
Amateur Newspapers from the American Antiquarian Society were a genre of nineteenth-century newspapers, written and published mainly by juvenile enthusiasts for the goal of publishing, not profiting. Some papers focused on general news, while others offered editorials, original literature, puzzles, or other matters of personal interest. In many ways, amateur newspapers can be thought of as the social media of their time, offering young adults a way to express their views and opinions.
- American Fiction, 1774-1920**
American Fiction, 1774-1920, demonstrates the utility of having more than 18,000 works of fiction in one place, in a consistent format. Titles up until 1900 are sourced from Lyle H. Wright's *American Fiction: A Contribution Towards a Bibliography*. Titles after 1900 are sourced from the Library of Congress Shelf List of American Adult Fiction and the Geoffrey D. Smith bibliography.
- American Historical Periodicals from the American Antiquarian Society**
American Historical Periodicals from the American Antiquarian Society offers a documentary history of the Colonial Americans in the twentieth century, presenting North American thought, culture, and society through a variety of perspectives. Focused on American concerns, they were predominantly published in the U.S., Canada, and by Americans living abroad. From long-running publications to ephemeral titles, each periodical offers a cross-section of the developing United States.
- Archives of Sexuality and Gender**
The Archives of Sexuality and Gender program provides a robust and significant collection of primary sources for the historical study of sex, sexuality, and gender. With material dating back to the sixteenth century, researchers and scholars can examine how sexual norms have changed over time, health and hygiene, the development of sex education, the rise of sexology, changing gender roles, LGBTQ culture, social movements and activism, erotica, and many other interesting topical areas.
- Archives Unbound**
Archives Unbound addresses students and scholars' pressing need to see primary, unpublished archival documents. There is no better way to study the past than through consultation of primary source documents. Archives Unbound presents topically-focused digital collections of historical documents that support the research and study needs of scholars and students at the college and university level.
- Associated Press Collections Online**
Associated Press Collections Online gives insight into major events, people and trends from the mid-1800s through the twentieth century from the Associated Press Corporate Archive. Collections may include: original wire copy, personal papers, AP style books, internal publications, and more. Hundreds of videos from the AP Archive and thousands of striking images from AP Images archive add depth to the original reporting and stories behind the news from this venerable news agency.
- Brazilian and Portuguese History and Culture**
The Oliveira Lima Library has been lauded as the finest collection of Luso-Brazilian material available to U.S. scholars. With the core of its content derived from the "long" nineteenth century, this collection turns the spotlight on South America's largest and most influential power, covering topics such as colonialism, missionaries, slave trade and abolition, economic development and agricultural trade, Indigenous Peoples, international relations, and the fight for Brazilian independence.
- British Library Newspapers**
British Library Newspapers contains full runs of influential national and regional newspapers representing different political and cultural segments of British society.
- China and the Modern World**
China and the Modern World is a multi-module digitization and publishing program that documents China's transformation from an imperial dynasty into a modern republic. Consisting of monographs, manuscripts, periodicals, correspondence and letters, photos, and other kinds of historical documents, these collections provide excellent primary source material for the understanding and research of the various aspects of China during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.
- Crime, Punishment, and Popular Culture, 1790-1920**
Crime, Punishment, and Popular Culture, 1790-1920 presents a broad history of crime in the long nineteenth century derived from French, German, Spanish, Australian, British and U.S. sources. The collection includes trial transcripts, court proceedings, police and forensic documents, photographs, true crime literature and detective novels, and newspaper accounts. This archive appeals to scholars in the fields of history, literature, law and criminal justice, as well as other fields.
- Daily Mail Historical Archive, 1896-2004**
The Daily Mail has been at the heart of British journalism since 1896, regularly changing the course of government policy and setting the national debate. As well as providing access to the regular edition of this path-breaking newspaper, the archive also contains the Atlantic Editions, printed on board the transatlantic cruise liners between 1923 and 1931.
- Eighteenth Century Collections Online**
Use Eighteenth Century Collections Online to access the digital images of every page of books published during the 18th Century. With full-text searching of millions of pages, the product allows researchers new methods of access to critical information in the fields of history, literature, religion, law, fine arts, science and more.
- Financial Times Historical Archive**

Indigenous Peoples of North America sources collections from Canadian and American institutions, providing insight into the cultural, political and social history of Native Peoples from the seventeenth into the twentieth century including diverse manuscripts, book collections, newspapers from various tribe and Indian-related organizations, materials such as Bibles, dictionaries and primers in Indigenous languages all enable students' examination of important primary source materials.

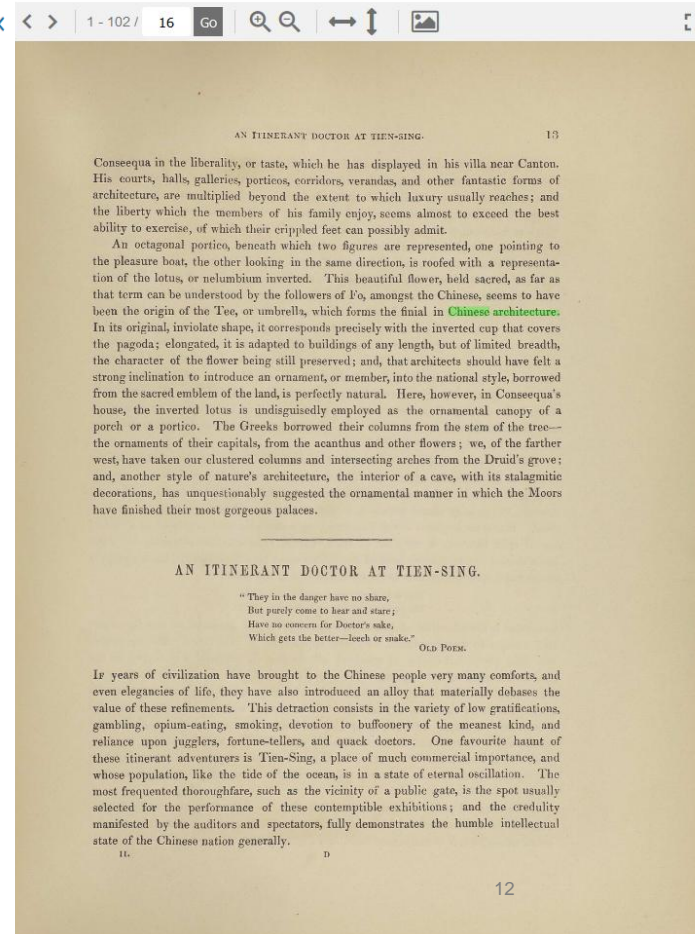

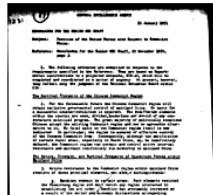

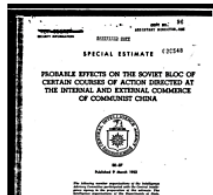


Position of the U.S. with respect to Communist China

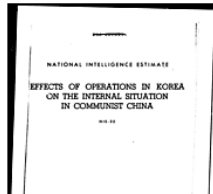

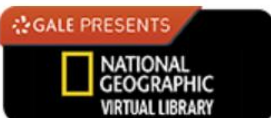
